Six Types of Dharma



- Varna
- Ashram
- Varnaashram
- Goun
- Nimit
- Saadhaaran



The Four Varnas



- Brahmins - teach, perform non-violent yagnas, receive alms
- Kshatriyas - protect the land, engage the enemy, rule honourably
- Vaishyas - farming, trading, serving cows
- Shudras - serving the above with honour and honesty



The Four Aashrams



- Brahmcharya - simple student
- Grahasth - householder
- Vaanprasth - retirement
- Sanyas - hermits life



Niyams



- Never to indulge into violence of even the smallest creature
- Refrain from contact of other woman or other male
- Never to indulge into meat-eating even at the cost of life or as residue of God
- Never to resort to intoxicants even as a medicine



Niyams (cont...)



- Never to touch even a widow
- Never to commit suicide even in the case of a big sin or unavoidable circumstances
- Never resort to stealing even if it is for religious purposes
- Never to blame anybody or falsely implicate anybody



Niyams (cont..)



- Never criticise any God or deity
- Never eat from one who is not in communion
- Never listen to even Godly discourse from one who is an atheist, pretender, hypocrite
